

	The Maneka Gandhi case arose in the period immediately following the end of the national	
	Emergency in India, with the Janta Party government assuming the power in 1977. Maneka Gandhi, daughter-in-law of former Prime Minister Indira Gandhi and founder-editor of a political magazine	
	Surya, was issued a passport in 1976 under Passports Act. Soon after the Congress Party was ousted	
	by the Janta Party, she begin using Surya as a political platform to restore the image of the Congress	
	Party and discredit leaders of the new government. (The most notable instance of this given was
